

Easter Crowns

Materials...

- Green corrugated card
- Green card
- Felt tips
- Funky foam shapes
- Glue stick
- Stapler
- Red and black card



Process...

1. Begin by measuring around the heads of children. Staple the crown in place at the back.
2. Start by adding details like flowers by colouring in templates or making flowers out of pipe cleaners & tissue paper.
3. To make tissue paper flowers wrap pipe cleaner around crown base and attach on yellow tissue to make daffodils on the ends.
4. Make little ladybirds from red and black card by cutting out red base and adding black cut out face and dots. You could also draw on red card with a black marker.
5. Add on any further details like foam cut outs from funky foam, eggs, chicks, and bunny ears. Add sequins and/or glitter as required!

Other Ideas...

Once you have mastered this technique why not try this flower bouquet for Mothers Day? Just wrap the crown tighter and add more flowers to create a bouquet!



Egg Window Decoration

Materials...

- Tissue paper
- Scissors
- White card egg cut out
- Window wobbler



Process...

1. Start by covering the back of your Easter egg cut out with glue.
2. Tear tiny pieces of tissue paper to make little shapes of different coloured tissue.
3. Start applying your torn pieces of tissue to the back of cut out, working your way around until all gaps are covered in tissue.
4. Add window wobbler to back of egg cut out and let dangle in window so that the light shines through the tissue paper giving a stained glass effect.
5. If you do not have a window wobbler you could try using card and some blue tack or sellotape.

Rocking Paper Plate Chick

Materials...

- Paper plate
- Yellow and orange paint (or you could use thick markers)
- Orange and yellow feathers
- Orange and yellow funky foam
- Googly eyes
- Orange card
- Scissors



Process...

1. Begin by colouring or painting the paper plate yellow. Allow to dry.
2. Fold the paper plate in half.
3. Cut out a circle for chick face and add googly eyes and orange funky foam beak.
4. Glue chick head to top right hand corner of folded plate.
5. Glue yellow feathers around funky foam chick face for fluffy effect.
6. Stick yellow feathers at the end of the chick for a tail.
7. Draw around hand on orange card and cut out. Stick this on to give wing effect.
